

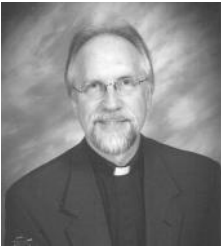

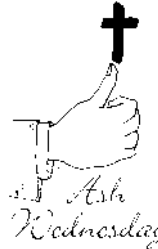
This weekend our high school youth are on their LifeTeen Retreat up at Baycliff Health Camp, and we appreciate your prayers and support for them!

At the Rite of Election, they'll be joined by catechumens and candidates from across the Diocese to express their desire to prepare for the Easter Sacraments and will be 'elected' by our Bishop to live this Lenten season in preparation for those Sacraments. Lenten Rules

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years of age and older are to refrain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.

Fasting: Only one full meal is permitted on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for Catholics between 18 and 59. Two smaller meals are permitted, but together they should not equal a second full meal.
