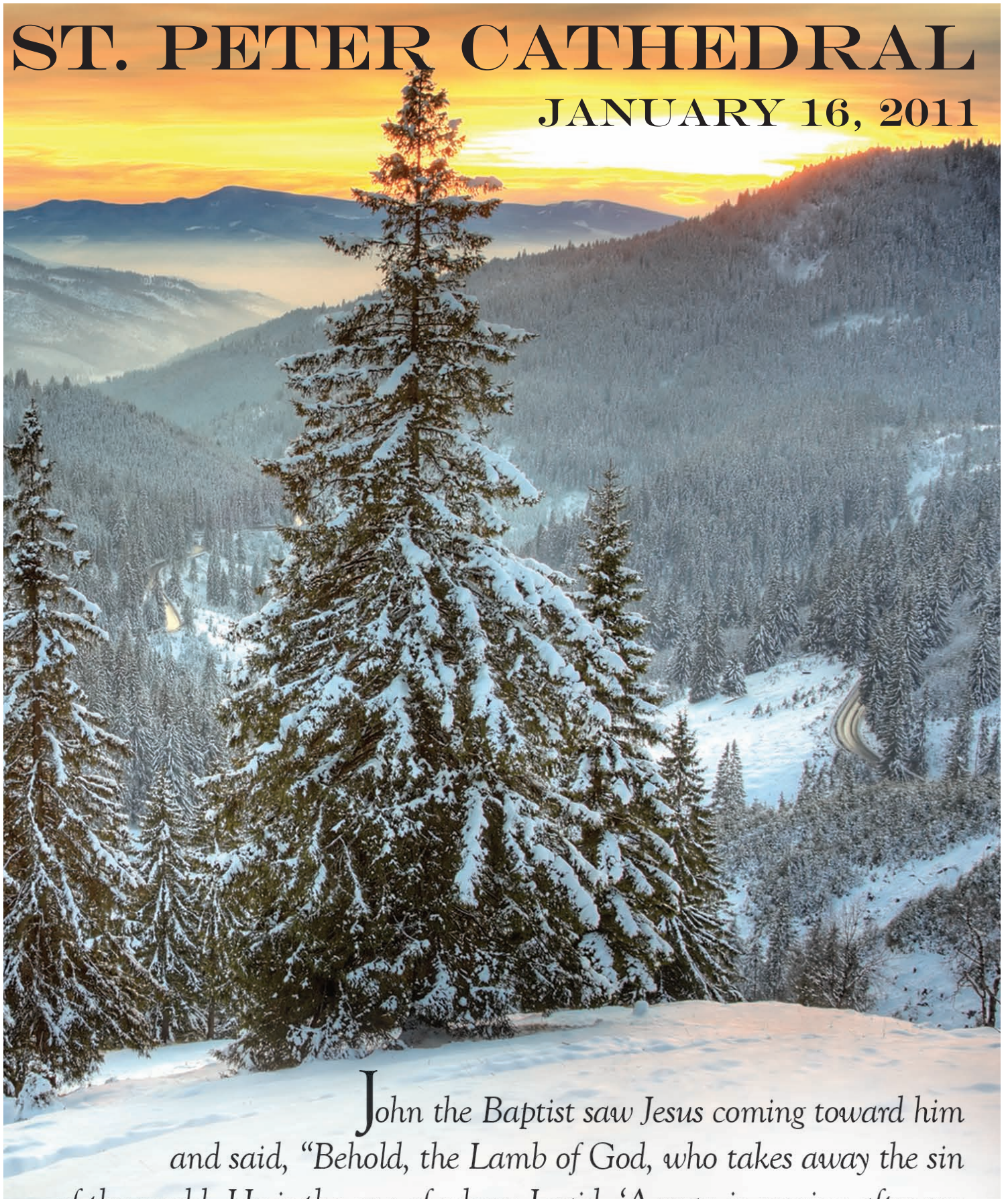
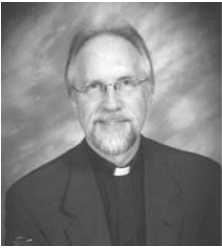

Dear Cathedral Parish Family,

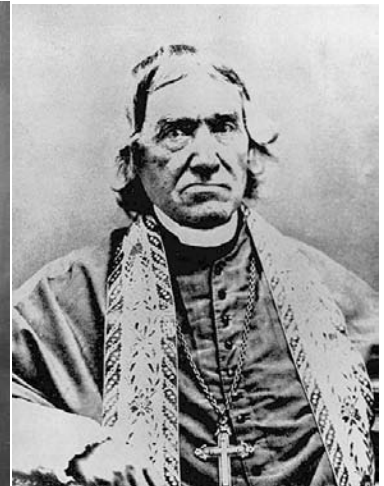
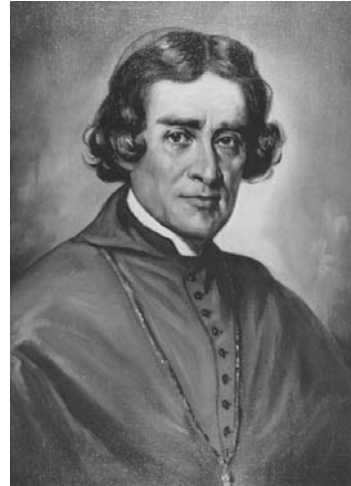

That evening at 7 p.m. there will be a Respect Life Prayer Service here at our Cathedral to respond to this call. Please plan to come and pray with others for healing of all affected by abortion and for building a culture of life. Fr. John and I hope to be making the trip to Washington, D.C. for the March for Life next weekend with others from the U.P. We'll be leaving on Jan. 21<sup>st</sup> and will be back by late Wed., Jan. 26<sup>th</sup>. God bless you deeply!

A new report in a prestigious medical journal (*American Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology*) confirms what previous studies have shown: abortion is associated with an increased risk of premature birth in subsequent pregnancies.
